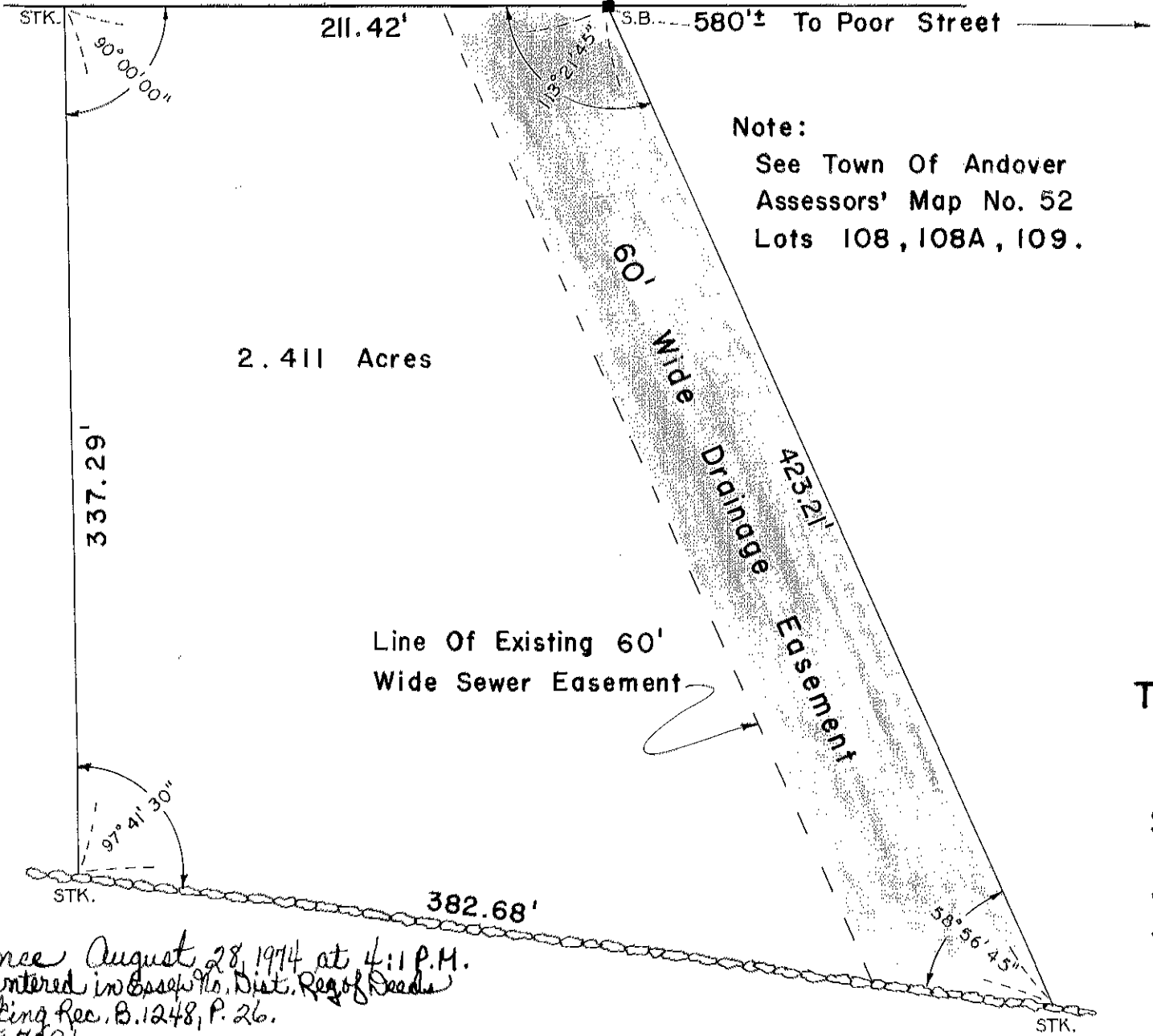

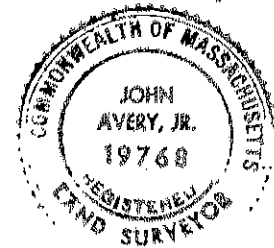

ORDER OF TAKING

WHEREAS, the Inhabitants of the Town of ANDover, voting upon Article 9 of the Annual Town Meeting held March, 1973, voted that the Selectmen be authorized to acquire by right of eminent domain, certain easements for the purpose of road drainage.

NOW, THEREFORE, Inhabitants of the Town of Andover, acting through its Selectmen, does hereby take, by right of eminent domain, a permanent easement in land in the Town of Andover, supposed to be owned by Rudolph Muto and Phyllis T. Muto, and shown as lots 198, 198A, and 109 on Town Assessor's Map 52. This taking shall be used for the purpose of road drainage, and for any other municipal uses. This taking shall include the right to enter the easement to install, construct, reconstruct, and forever maintain the drainage system.

Said easement to be located as shown on a Plan entitled, "Plan of Drainage Easement Rudolph Muto and Phyllis T. Muto to the Inhabitants of the Town of Andover, Massachusetts, Scale 1" = 60', December, 1972, John Avery, Jr., Town Engineer" to be recorded herewith.

The Selectmen in behalf of Inhabitants of the Town of Andover, hereby sign and execute this taking, and affix hereto, the seal of the Town of Andover, and cause this taking to be recorded in the Essex North District Registry of Deeds.
