The Solarize Mass Program utilizes a grassroots educational campaign to increase the adoption of small-scale photovoltaic solar electrical systems. MASSCEC offers different ways in which Massachusetts residents can equip their home with solar energy. The different financing options that solar providers offer are direct purchase, loans, solar leasing, or power purchase agreements. Through this program, **150 Andover households** were fitted with solar electrical systems.
